



Churchill Community College Football Academy Code of Conduct



Dear Student/Parent

The code of conduct is a written agreement between Churchill Community College and students enrolled upon the Football Academy. The Football Academy code of conduct refers to each student's attitude and commitment towards their education and practical ability. All players must ensure they read the expectations below and endeavour to achieve these at all times.

Each student will have the opportunity to combine their academic studies with expert coaching on a weekly basis. Students must attend or lessons and training sessions where appropriate. Training will be occurring on Monday mornings at 8:00am-9:30am and Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons from 1:30pm-3:30pm.

A student **SHOULD**:

- ✓ Make every effort to ensure the good name of Churchill Community College at all times.
- ✓ Demonstrate a positive attitude towards their education Post-16 and strive to be the best they can be
- ✓ Ensure commitment and responsibility towards the development of their education and aim to achieve the best results possible.
- ✓ Ensure commitment and responsibility towards the development of their individual skills
- ✓ Make every effort consistent with fair play and the laws of the game to help his team.
- ✓ Know and abide by the laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
- ✓ Accept the decision of the match officials and show due respect towards them.
- ✓ Show respect towards the officials, opposition and fellow supporters.

You **WILL**:

- ✓ Represent Churchill Community College in a **PROFESSIONAL** manner at all times at all occasions.
- ✓ Ensure that you attend all lessons, complete all work and stay up to date with all work at all times as well as ensuring you aim to do the best you possibly can. Failure to do so **WILL** result in the withdrawal from training & matches
- ✓ Students must endeavour to achieve 100% attendance and be punctual to tutor time, lessons, training and matches.
- ✓ Ensure that every training session is attended without **FAIL**. If injured rehabilitation training can still be completed. Failure to attend training sessions will result in the player being asked to withdraw from the Football Academy programme.
- ✓ Contact relevant staff members regarding injuries, illnesses or extenuating circumstances which could impact on your education or on the team.
- ✓ Ensure that official team training kit, strips are kept in good condition and all official team kit is worn when expected to ensure you represent the Football Academy in a professional manner. You will be asked to contribute to the purchase of your training kit.
- ✓ Look after all training equipment (i.e. balls, bibs, goal posts, net etc.) and ensure all equipment is accounted for at all times and leave changing rooms home & away in respectable condition.
- ✓ Ensure all strips are looked after, washed and returned when requested.
- ✓ Players will be expected to ready 15 minutes before training starts. All equipment must be set up at least 30 minutes before each home game to ensure a thorough warm-up can take place.
